Behaviour

If the student behaves in any way deemed unacceptable by the Head of Immersion and Holiday Courses, we reserve the right to send the student home immediately, with no refund of fees. In respect to damages, caused deliberately or as a result of inappropriate behaviour, Windermere Holiday Schools will recover costs from the parents or guardians of the child or children involved.

Insurance

Except where required by the terms of its own insurance cover, Windermere Holiday Schools does not accept liability for damages, injuries, illnesses or other claims related to students unless such liability is legally imposed.

Medical

We accept students only on the understanding that they are in good health. The Medical and Dietary information allows you to give us an insight in to your child's health and dietary needs, but we can take no responsibility for any aspects not included. Please give a full account in writing if there are any additional concerns or matters about which we need to know.

Changes to the programme

The course has been planned and published in good faith. Windermere Holiday Schools reserves the right to make any changes to the programme or cancel the course if it is deemed necessary.

Course cancellation

To cancel a student's place, Windermere Holiday Schools must receive written confirmation. This will take effect from the date the letter is received. The following cancellation charges will apply:

- 45 days or more: £35 administrative fee
- 14 to 45 days: £100 (50% of fees)
- 14 days or less: No refund

In the event that the school needs to cancel the course, a full refund will be provided.
