Private Lessons and Optional Extras (per term)

Travel Day Transport

Transport to/from Manchester or Liverpool Airport on designated travel days £35 per journey

Non-Travel Day Transport

Transport to/from Manchester or Liverpool Airports outside designated travel days £150 per journey

Tuition in English as an Additional Language

One hour per week English as an Additional Language (average 10 per term) £255 per term

Registration Fee

One off non-refundable fee of £50 payable on registration with the school

Acceptance Deposits

Residents in the UK Reception - Year 6 £400

Residents outside the EU Equivalent to the first term's tuition and boarding fee

Notice

One full term's notice is required in writing to the Headmaster if withdrawing a student or to cancel private lessons. Failing this one term's fees in lieu of notice will be payable.



Notes on Fees and Charges

Boarding and Tuition

Fees are charged per term and cover curriculum tuition, meals (including lunch for day students), participation in most School run activities after lessons and at weekends. Additional charges for special events, transport, public examination fees and some teaching materials will be notified to parents. Fees are payable by the first day of term.

Termly fees represent the overall cost of education and accommodation, averaged to an amount per term. There are 3 terms per year.

Scholarships, Bursaries and Discounts

Academic, Performing Arts, Visual Arts and Sport scholarships are awarded on merit and may attract a fee discount subject to means testing. Means tested Bursaries may be granted at the Governors' discretion and are subject to the availability of funds.

Sibling Discounts, (excluding Pre-School):

Second child 5%, third child 25%, subsequent children 50%

Acceptance Deposits

On entering the School an Acceptance Deposit is payable. This is held for the duration of the student's attendance, and the balance is returned when the student leaves after payment of any outstanding monies owed. A 50% discount applies to deposits for the second child, and no deposit is required for the third child. Deposits vary according to the point of entry. Where siblings attend the School, the smaller of the deposits is returned as each family member leaves.
