### Travel Day Transport

Senior Dedicated 1:1 In-Class Support £360 per term, per subject, for one lesson per week on average

Where a fee is quoted per term, unless otherwise stated, charges are based on 30 lessons per academic year, averaging 10 per term. If a higher level of support is required, it may be possible to provide dedicated 1:1 in-class support. Private Academic Tuition and individual support outside of the classroom, where appropriate may be provided in small groups and will therefore be charged accordingly, 1:2 £180 per term, 1:3 £120 per term etc.



## After-School Activities and Watersports/Sports Tuition

The School runs a busy activity program after school and at the weekends. This changes each term in line with demand and the seasons. Many activities are free, but some are chargeable because there is a transport component or because they are provided by an external agency. Charges are normally for a half term or term, and occasionally on a session by session basis.

Examples of free activities and clubs include: Art Club, Drama Club, Baking Club, Chemistry Club, Maths Club, Music Practice, Creative Workshop, Round Square Club, Native Spanish, Native German and French Conversation Club.

Examples of free sporting activities include: Recreational Canoeing and Kayaking, Recreational Sailing, Athletics, Football (Girls and Boys), Cross-Country Running, Jogging Club and Circuit Training.

There may be charges if there is an external cost or significant transport requirements. Examples include: Ten Pin Bowling £10, Maize Maze £10, Laser Tag £10, Visit to the Trafford Centre £25, Mountain Biking £30, Tree Top Trek £25, Paintballing £35, Go Karting £45.
