The School offers three return bus services:

1. Barrow via Dalton, Ulverston, Greenodd, Newby Bridge. 2. Kendal, Burneside & Staveley. 3. Milnthorpe, Bowness and Windermere.

School Mini buses and drivers are used to provide this service with support from Travellers Choice coaches and local taxi service if required.
All drivers are DBS checked and hold appropriate licences.

Cost. Each place on a school bus is charged per full term (i.e. "season ticket") and assumes that the service is used each day the school is open to pupils. Less than a full term's commitment to a service will make it unviable and empty places could otherwise be offered to other students. Termly bus charges are not subject to refund for occasional non-attendance and when withdrawing a child from a bus service this must be done in writing a minimum of one calendar month before the end of term.

Application. All parents who wish their children to use these bus services must complete this form for each individual child and email it to Transport@windermerschool.co.uk or mail it to Senior School Reception to reserve a place. Once a place has been allocated, thereafter it will be charged to parents at the start of each term, via fee invoices.

Code of Conduct. It is important that bus-users comply with this Code of Conduct when using the School's bus services; otherwise they will be barred from travelling. If this happens then the balance of bus charges for the term during which the sanction is enforced will not be refunded.

- Passengers must comply with any Health and Safety procedures required of them and any other reasonable requests made by the driver.
- Passengers must wear seat belts at all times.
- Personal bags and luggage must be stored safely so that they do not endanger others or impede access to and from the bus.
- Any damage, including graffiti, will be charged to the passengers concerned, and this and any other untoward behaviour will result in being barred from further use of the bus.
- Buses must be left free of litter.
- Parents must make suitable arrangements to ensure that they arrive at pick-up / drop off points in good time. The bus will not wait for pupils who are late and neither can pupils be left to await collection. If parents have not arrived on time to collect a pupil on the evening service, then the pupil will be required to stay on the School's transport until a parent is able to "intercept" the bus at another point on its schedule.
