# Model United Nations (12 - 16 yrs)

Model United Nations is an exercise in research, public speaking, and teamwork. Students are placed in committees and act as delegates for a specific country at a simulated UN conference. Solutions and actions are proposed by delegates to tackle real world issues and problems. You will develop skills such as strategic thinking, negotiation, preparing documents and problem-solving. Delegates also need to demonstrate their willingness to present and defend their country's best interests during debates.



You will learn about the United Nations, diplomacy and international relations and increase your understanding of current world issues. This experience and the skills that you develop will be an asset throughout your career and will be a useful addition to any CV or resume.



Residential courses are available for students aged 12 to 16. Students will live in a comfortable boarding house under the care of resident Houseparent and Activity staff. The cost includes the course, all meals and snacks, accommodation, supervision and entertainment from Sunday evening to Saturday morning.

# Travelling to Windermere

**Rail:** The School's Senior campus at Browhead is a five minute taxi ride from Windermere railway station. High speed rail services connect London Euston to Oxenholme (Lake District) in under 3 hours. From Oxenholme (Lake District) there are connections to Windermere station which take approximately 20 minutes.

**Road:** The school is easily accessible by road. From the M6, leave the motorway at Junction 36 and join the A590 towards Kendal which becomes the A591 just before Kendal. Continue on to the A591 into Windermere. Turn right at the mini-roundabout on to the A592 towards Penrith and the School's Browhead campus is located about a mile along this road on the right-hand side.

**Hodge Howe:** From the M6, leave the motorway at Junction 36 and join the A590 towards Kendal which becomes the A591 just before Kendal. Continue on to the A591 into Windermere. Go through the mini-roundabout and, immediately after it, turn left on the private road. Continue along the road for about half a mile down to the lake.

The market town of Windermere is approximately one mile from the School's Senior campus.

## Other Short Courses
