RYA Sailing (mornings) and Recreational Sailing (afternoons)

Learn to sail or develop your existing skills at Hodge Howe, Windermere School's private Watersports Centre on the shores of Lake Windermere. Located a short distance from the school, it has two boathouses, a private beach and a pavilion with classroom and changing facilities, showers and toilets. Hodge Howe is accredited by the Royal Yachting Association (RYA) as an officially recognized club for British Youth Sailing. Windermere School is the only school in the UK to hold this status.

We have a range of boats including Bugs, Picos, Lasers and Fevas. Safety is always our top priority; all safety equipment is provided for you and our team of experienced and well-qualified staff ensure you are happy and safe on the water.

Both RYA and Recreational Sailing are suitable for completed beginners and experienced sailors. On the RYA course, you will work you way through the RYA Youth Sailing Syllabus, collecting awards as you complete each level. You will receive a RYA Youth Sailing Log Book (or add to your existing log book) at the end of your course. Alternatively, our afternoon recreational sailing courses offer the opportunity to be out on the lake in a more relaxed setting.

Residential Option

For students aged 11 to 17, a weekly residential package is available from Sunday evening to Saturday morning, at an additional cost of £360. Students will live in one of our comfortable boarding houses with pastoral care and supervision, all meals, drinks and snacks, and evening entertainment provided. An 'bridging' weekend package is also available for an additional £150 per weekend to combine two or more courses into a longer stay.

Travelling to Windermere

Rail: The School's Senior campus at Browhead is a five minute taxi ride from Windermere railway station. High speed rail services connect London Euston to Oxenholme (Lake District) in under 3 hours. From Oxenholme (Lake District) there are connections to Windermere station which take approximately 20 minutes.

Road: The school is easily accessible by road. From the M6, leave the motorway at Junction 36 and join the A590 towards Kendal which becomes the A591 just before Kendal. Continue on to the A591 into Windermere. Turn right at the mini-roundabout on to the A592 towards Penrith and the School's Browhead campus is located about a mile along this road on the right-hand side.

Hodge Howe: From the M6, leave the motorway at Junction 36 and join the A590 towards Kendal which becomes the A591 just before Kendal. Continue on to the A591 into Windermere. Go through the mini-roundabout and, immediately after it, turn left on the private road. Continue along the road for about half a mile down to the lake.

The market town of Windermere is approximately one mile from the School's Senior campus.
