Where to come

Locations:
The West End at Windermere Courses are taught at Windermere School’s Browhead Campus. Please drop off and collect your child from the railings just beyond the front door as you drive around the one-way system.

Directions:
From the M6 Northbound and Southbound:

- Leave the M6 at junction 36 and join the A590 towards Kendal
- Just before Kendal, leave the A590 and join the A591 Kendal by-pass towards Windermere and Kendal.
- Continue into Windermere passing the Windermere Hotel. The Junior School, Elleray Campus is located on the right hand side, after the traffic lights, but do not stop here.
- For the Senior School campus at Browhead, turn right at the roundabout onto the A592. The school is on the right, about one mile up.

Course timings

The course starts at 9.30am each morning, Monday to Friday.

Collection is at 4.30pm each day.

Drop-off and collection is at the railings, just past the font door of Browhead campus. A member of the team will greet you on arrival. For COVID security reasons, parents should remain in their cars.

What to bring?

Children should wear comfortable clothing, for example:

- Leggings
- Tracksuits
- T-shirts
- Trainers

Each child will need to bring a smart phone and charger. Children can bring their own musical instrument and editing software on a laptop if they wish, but these will also be provided.

What to expect

Participants will take part in various workshops throughout the week and receive an hour’s 1-to-1 tuition in either vocal, guitar, or production and recording and be assisted in writing and recording at least one finished demo by the end of the week; mixed & mastered, and ready to take home.

Food and Drink

- School will provide a packed lunch each day
- Pupils are permitted to bring snacks if they wish
- Please bring a bottle of water / refillable drinks bottle

Medication

Any personal medication – such as an inhaler must be brought to the course with clear written instructions and permission slips filled in by parents / carers and handed to the lead instructor at the start of each day.

COVID-19 information

We have been very fortunate to be COVID-free on our Browhead campus and we are keen to ensure we remain this way. We are asking all attendees to take a lateral flow test the weekend before the course starts (or on the Monday), as well as tutors. Should you need a lateral flow test from the school, please contact us, alternatively these are readily from local chemists. Children are not required to wear face masks, but may do so if they prefer.
