Expectations

We hope that this guide provides you with all the information you need to ensure your child has the correct clothing and equipment in school at all times.

Please note the following dress expectations:


- Any pupil may be sent to change if their dress is deemed inappropriate.
- In extreme weather pupils may obtain permission from the Head of Sixth Form to wear protective clothing and footwear.
- · No visible tattoos are permitted
- Jewellery and accessories should be professional, smart and not in excess. Tooth gems are not permitted.

Piercings

- Piercing can include up to 2 earrings (studs or small hoops) in each ear lobe.
- An additional migraine piercing bar may be authorised by the Head of Sixth Form with a letter from the doctor when over 16 years of age.
- A nose piercing is permitted (in Sixth Form only) provided a plain stud of no bigger than 1.5mm or a clear retainer bar is worn in school.
- · No other piercings are permitted.

Hair

- · Boys should be cleanly shaved.
- · Hair should be professional and tidy: clean and groomed.
- Hair should not rest below the eyebrows (eyes must be visible).
- Two tone, unnatural or extreme colours are not permitted (no bleach blonde or black). Warm colours, are acceptable (as shown).
- Longer hair must be tied up when required: for F&N, PE, Science etc
 or put up without fuss when a member of staff asks. Therefore,
 pupils must carry a hair toggle if their hair is long enough.
- · Short hair should be no shorter than a grade 3.



Nails

- Acrylic nails are not permitted.
- Professional, non-chipped nail varnish is permitted.

Make-up

Subtle, professional make-up in Sixth Form.

Sixth Form Girls may wear:

- A plain navy, black or dark grey tailored suit, comprising of either matching full length trousers and jacket or a matching knee length skirt and jacket.
 - ~ Trousers should be full length and not skin tight.
 - ~ The hem line of skirts and dresses must be touching the knee.
 - ~ No cardigans or lycra skirts are allowed.
- A non-translucent blouse or shirt (with sleeves) under their suits and, if the weather dictates, a plain smart jumper.
 - ~ No t-shirts or inappropriate necklines showing.
- Jewellery and accessories should be professional and smart.
- Dark coloured, plain, smart shoes, or smart sandals in the summer, suitable for the terrain. Plain tights or socks may be worn.
 - ~ No mules, trainers or Ugg boots.
 - ~ Ankle boots are permitted under trousers only.
- Foundation, blusher, subtle eye shadow, mascara and discrete nail varnish.

Sixth Form Boys may wear:

- A plain navy, black or dark grey tailored suit.
 - ~ No jeans or chinos.
 - ~ Trousers should not be skin tight.
- A plain shirt and sensible tie of their own choice and, if the weather dictates, a plain smart jumper.
- Black or brown polished shoes and dark coloured socks.
 - ~ No trainers
